distance of the museum and they have offered us a

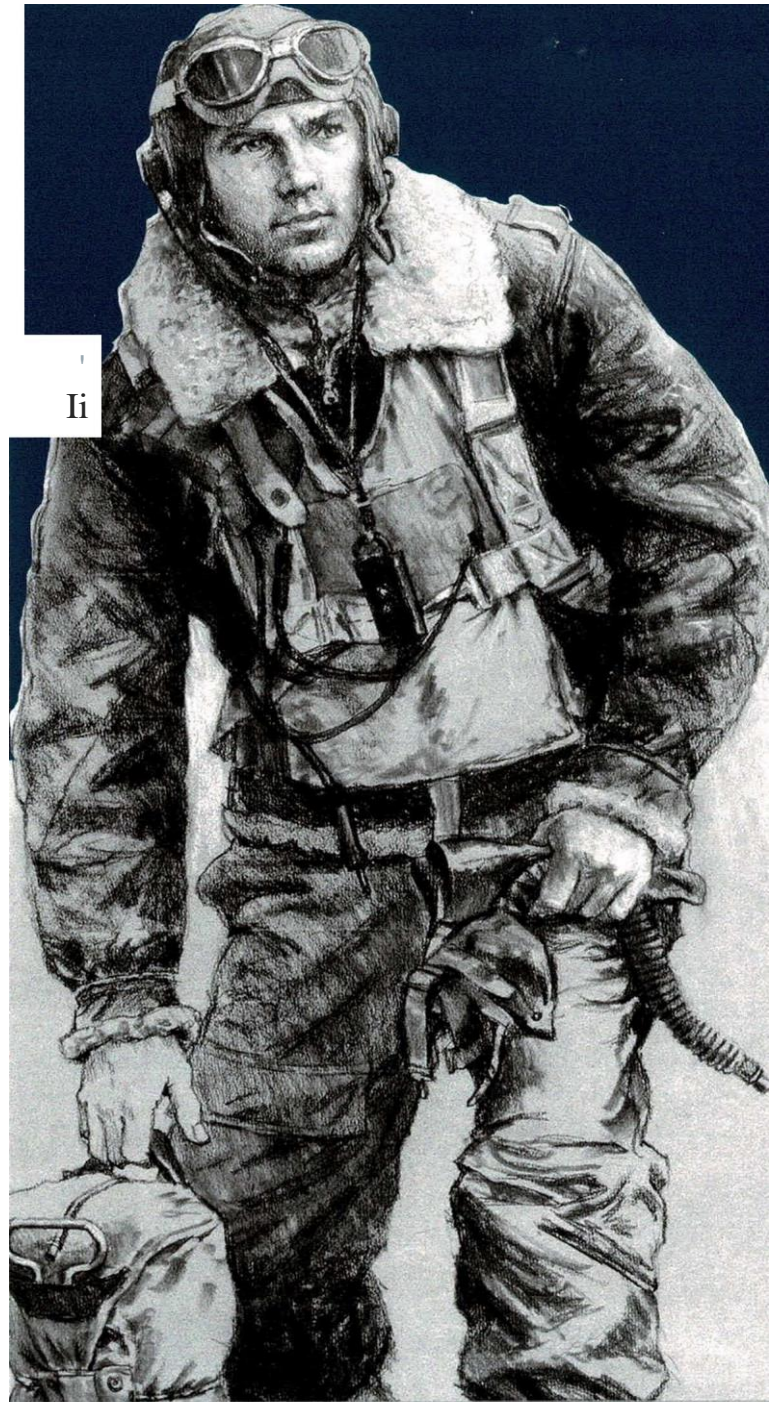
special rate of \$84 per room per day plus tax. They will
